Creative Europe – MEDIA programme provides support to Training activities aiming at:

- improving the capacity of the A/V sector to operate transnationally and internationally including knowledge-sharing, networking capabilities, talent development, marketing, promotion and innovation;
- improving the competitiveness of the A/V sector on European and international markets and to have a structural effect on European companies including testing new business models and enhancing the capacity to access finance, as well as through linkages with financial instruments;
- improving the circulation of European A/V works on international markets including audience development and new distribution models in particular in ways to reach new and young audiences;
- improving the capacity of the A/V sector to integrate digital and new technologies including in the field of animation.

The call for proposals EACEA/09/2018 is open to entities in the audiovisual sector (private companies, non-profit organisations, associations, charities, foundations, municipalities/Town Councils, etc.) established and active in one of the countries

participating in the MEDIA Sub-programme (see below) and owned directly or by majority participation, by nationals from such countries.

The applicant are invited to submit a proposal in view of establishing a three year partnership with the MEDIA Sub-programme, through a contractual instrument called Framework Partnership Agreement ("FPA"). The FPA will allow the selected institutions a long term forward planning and financial stability to implement repetitive annual actions for three years.

The total budget earmarked for the co-financing of projects is estimated at EUR 7.5 M
