Agustina Lumi is a film and TV producer, trained in the field of Social Communications at UBA (University of Buenos Aires, Argentina). She developed her career in the main Argentine production companies and broadcasters working on factual content for TV and several feature documentaries which toured and were premiered in different festivals and markets around the world.

She was part of INCAA (National Institute of Cinema and Audiovisual Arts) in Argentina for almost ten years. As head of their Exhibition Department - and with a strong role as Media Content Manager for CINE.AR TV / CINE.AR PLAY (VoD) and INCAA's public cinemas - she deepened in the development of audience strategies, public policies and promotion to help grow communities interested in Argentine movies and content.

In addition to her audiovisual expertise, in 2009 she began teaching as a Professor for Social Communications in public high-schools and universities in Argentina, giving workshops on Journalism and Media Reading as well as Growing Audiences laboratories.

She is currently based in Madrid representing Argentine production companies and is part of the EUROVOD team as Tech Project Manager for EUROVOD PRO, the Professional Platform which will launch its Beta version in October 2020.
